Course Selection Steps

- Review the Educational Planning Guide and the Course Selection List.
- Choose your courses for the fall and spring semesters.
- Discuss options and courses with your parents.
- Select one course from each of the 4 core subjects: English, Math, Science, and Social Studies and add onto your Course Selection Card.
- ♦ List elective courses in order of preference.
- ♦ Make sure you have 7 credits.
- List four alternate electives in order of preference.
- Meet all application deadlines.
- Notify the Counselor prior to the first day of class if prerequisites have not been met. Counselors will verify your selections with your four-year plan.

Completing the Course Selection Card

- Any required applications must be turned in to the appropriate teacher or coordinator by the posted deadline.
- Students must list 4 core credit courses, 3 elective credits, and 2.5 alternate credit courses.


Course Selection Cards are due by Monday, February 20, 2018.

- Students have until May 4, 2018 to make changes to next year's course selections.






Clear Creek ISD Freshmen Course Selection
