

Clear Creek High School Film Festival

Participants:

- At least one member of the production team must be currently enrolled and attending CCHS. All members of the production team must be enrolled full time at a CCISD school.
- Adult involvement in the project is limited to sponsors and onscreen talent.
- Production team members must be passing at the time of the festival screening.

Entries:

- Students may submit an unlimited number of entries.
- Entries can be in the following styles:
 - Narrative (including but not limited to, original scores, silent film, horror shorts, music videos, etc. etc.)
 - Documentary
 - Computer/Digital animation
 - Traditional animation (including Claymation, hand drawn, stop motion, etc.) This does not include live actors films and then edited to create a “strobe” effect.
 - Works submitted as class projects are encouraged to be submitted to the film festival.
- Narrative and documentary films shall be no longer than 7 minutes, and animated films shall be no longer than 3 minutes. This includes any credits.

Eligible Material

- Submitted films must be original works and are required to have clearances for music or other copyrighted material featured in the project.
- The administration of CCHS shall assure that the production does not offend the moral standards of the community. Films that do not meet the moral standards of our community will not be shown.

Entry Procedures

- Submission on or before – January 25, 2019
